Fig. 1 The preclinical effect of ABM on the expression of IL-1 beta & IL-6 mRNA in macrophages

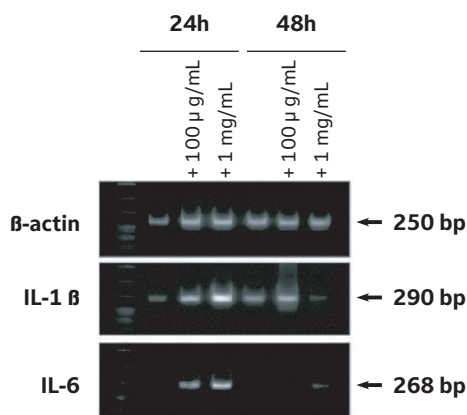
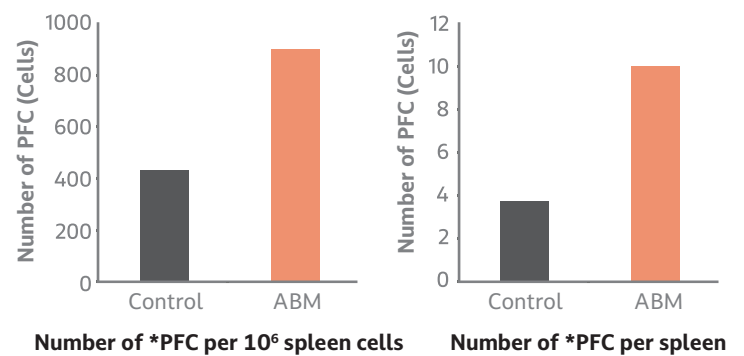


Fig. 2 The preclinical effect of ABM extracts on the number of PFC cells
